Where is Cavan Burren Park?

Cavan Burren Park, outside Blacklion in County Cavan has been transformed into an accessible prehistoric park with a new interpretative centre and five new walking trails.

Cavan Burren Park is an area of unique geological and archaeological importance and is part of the UNESCO designated Marble Arch Caves Global Geopark, which encompasses a variety of spectacular sites in Cavan and Fermanagh.

Cavan Burren Park is one of the finest integrated prehistoric landscapes in Ireland with fine examples of megalithic tombs, huts, stone walls, ancient rock art, glacial erratics and pre-bog walls.

Where is Cavan Burren Park?

Cavan Burren Park is located on the slopes of Cuilcagh Mountain in West Cavan. From Blacklion, take the N16 Sligo Road. Take a left for Glangevlin. Follow the signs for approx. 4km until you reach Cavan Burren Park.
